Parking

I have again received complaints about inconsiderate parking at the end of the school day. Please do not park on any of the corners with Chiltern Road, or block people's driveways even if it might be for 5 minutes. Residents should not have to negotiate badly parked cars when entering or leaving their properties. There is plenty of room to park in the side roads as soon as you enter Chiltern Road, or preferably you could walk to school to collect your child/children. I am sure you all saw the Maidenhead Advertiser's headline last week naming and shaming Windsor and Maidenhead as the nation's 'laziest' Borough!!

I would also like to remind you that you must not use the service road next to the school, or the staff entrance due to Health, Safety and Insurance reasons. You should always use the pedestrian gate at the front of the school, at all times.

After school clubs

We have many after school clubs running this term and I would like to advise parents, particularly those with younger children in Key Stage One, that they should make themselves available at the end of the school day to help them get changed for these activities ie. gymnastics, tennis. Unfortunately, members of staff are not available to help with this at 3.20pm.

Whilst we endeavour to advise parents when an activity is cancelled at short notice, ie. due to the weather, we will always make sure children are supervised at school until they can be collected at the normal time the club would have finished.

Cash for Schools 2011

We will be collecting the 'Cash for Schools' vouchers from the 'Maidenhead Advertiser' starting next Thursday, 27th January. 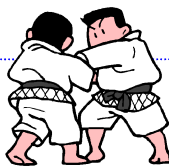


Well done!

Netball



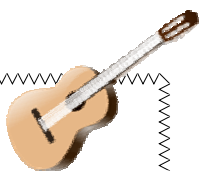
Oldfield B Netball team played at
